2. **GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS** The public may provide comments to the board on non-agenda items within the Wilmington Neighborhood Councils subject matter jurisdiction. However, please note that under the Brown Act, the board is prevented from acting on the issue you bring to its attention until the matter is agendized for discussion at a future Monthly Governing Board and Stakeholder meeting. (Limited to 2 minutes per speaker, unless otherwise adjusted by the presiding officer.)
3. **AGENDA SETTING** Discussion and consideration of items to be placed on the agenda for the September 27, 2017 Governing Board and Stakeholder meeting of the Wilmington Neighborhood Council. Agenda items submitted by stakeholders, Board members, governmental entities, and other interested individuals and organizations will be reviewed during this time. The WNC board has the discretion to postpone an agenda request, refer it to a specific Standing or Ad hoc Committee for review and recommendation, treat it as an announcement, or consider and resolve it as a non-Board administrative matter. NOTE: During this Ad hoc Agenda Setting Committee, Board members present shall not address or consider the merits, reasons, or justifications of proposed agenda items.

PUBLIC INPUT AT NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL MEETINGS — The public can address the Committee on any agenda item before the Committee takes an action on an item. Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered. Comments from the public on other matters not appearing on the agenda will be heard during the General Public Comment period. Please note that under the Brown Act, the Committee is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Committee meeting.

STATE OF CALIFORNIA PENAL CODE SECTION 403 (Amended by Stats. 1994, Ch. 923, Sec. 159. Effective January 1, 1995.) — Every person who, without authority of law, willfully disturbs or breaks up any assembly or meeting that is not unlawful in its character, other than an assembly or meeting referred to in Section 302 of the Penal Code or Section 18340 of the Elections Code, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
