2. Action Items:

A. Discussion and Possible Action to recommend to the WNC full governing board to submit a CIS and/or Addendum/Letter to the LA County Board of Supervisor on measure "A" funding for Wilmington.

B. Discussion and Possible Action to submit a Community Impact Statement for CF13-1493 Street Vending

Information on street vending was given on the council file and folks discussed the impact they personally experienced and the business owners expressed their concerns about getting developers to invest here. The health concerns were addressed and how can this possibly be enforced city wide was brought up.
